**How are there 3 co-equal when Jesus considered God the Father to be Greater than Him?

***The Father and Son know One Another - No Holy Spirit mentioned - how can They be co-equal?

Not one gave a greeting that would set the Holy Spirit on the same level as God the Father and His Son.

If the Holy Spirit were part of the Godhead would the apostles ignore that fact? They would have had intimate and direct knowledge.
